**Moxidectin = Equest = + Praziquantel = Equest Pramox = use every 13 weeks**

To provide a complete and effective worming programme for horses and ponies it is recommended that you use one proprietary wormer throughout the year and alternate this on a yearly basis according to its active ingredient.

We recommend that you do a worm egg count once or twice a year. This will allow you to monitor the efficiency of your worming programme.

Any new horse in the yard should have a 5 day course of Panacur Guard 10% before it is turned out with other horses.

We currently provide a service that provides you with an annual worming pack which includes two free worm egg counts and all the wormers needed for the year if you would like more information about this service please contact the surgery and ask for Sarah.

If you practise good pasture management and do not have movement in and out of different animals, or have been receiving an annual worming pack with clear worm egg counts you may be able to go onto a reduced frequency worming plan.
